

2025 Year in Review



Homebuyer Education

A total of **194** residents from **132** households participated in NeighborWorks Lincoln's HUD-certified pre-purchase education program.

New Construction

Despite rising costs and extended construction timelines, NeighborWorks Lincoln built **12** new homes for low-to-moderate income first-time homebuyers.



Rehabilitation

NeighborWorks Lincoln completed **29** home rehabs for clients participating in the Homeownership Program.

Homeownership

NeighborWorks Lincoln helped **37** low-to-moderate income families achieve the dream of first-time homeownership.



Mobilizing Resources

NeighborWorks Lincoln mobilized **\$486,367** to support home rehabilitation, and provided **\$1,027,236** to first-time homebuyers via down payment assistance.

Community Investment

NeighborWorks Lincoln leveraged **\$10,152,141** in public, private, and philanthropic investment.
